EASY PLACES TO GET FUEL VT I-91 & NH I-93

We have put this planning aid together to help our guests manage that one stressful feeling everyone who has driven their camper for a long-"er" ride knows, "Oh no, we need gas!" We put this list of suggested fuel stops together by searching on ... maps. We made a list, and then we drove to each one to make sure you have an easy approach to the pumps. Some we thought were okay turned out to not be ones that were not laid out well. The following list are suggestions for you. We are not recommending one brand of fuel over another, or fuel pricing. This list is based solely on ease of access which is what you really need when you look down and realize the calculated distance, your MPG, is wrong because you are climbing up into the mountains and are running out of fuel.

Vermont Gas/Diesel Stations Interstate 91

Once you enter Vermont you will be pulling a lot of hills and your vehicles estimated fuel mileage will be short of you making it to our campground. There are not a lot of options for fuel stops in VT as the exits are far between. Of the options, not many stations can accommodate you pulling in with a camper in tow. Here are some easy access options for you.

Starting from southern Vermont and heading north:

Exit 7 - Springfield, VT

Route 5 South, Circle K Truck Stop - Irving, Gas & Diesel, 24 hours

Recommend follow signs for trucks, going behind building will line you up for gas pumps.

Exit 8 - Weathersfield, VT

Route 131 East, Sunoco, Gas & Diesel, closes at 9 PM.

Route 131 East, Mobil, Gas & Diesel, Closes at 11 PM.

These are across the street from each other.

Exit 17 - Wells River, VT - Woodsville, NH

Route 302 West, P&H Truck Stop, Mobil Gas & Diesel, 24 hours

New Hampshire Gas/Diesel Stations Interstate 93

Southern New Hampshire is very populated along the major state and interstate highways. There obviously will be plenty of fuel options. The following are ones that provide easy access for large motor homes and those who are pulling a trailer.

Starting from Southern New Hampshire and heading north:

Hookset Welcome Center (North & Southbound), no exit number, but just north of exit 11 on I-93. Open 24 hours with gas & diesel, full-service rest stop and information.

Exit 23 - New Hampton, NH

Route 104 East, Circle K Truck Stop, Irving Gas & Diesel, 24 hours

Exit 24 - Ashland, NH

Route 3 South, Circle K, Irving Gas & Diesel 5 AM through 10 PM

Exit 25 - Plymouth, NH

Route 175A North, Circle K Truck Stop, Irving Gas & Diesel, 9 AM through Midnight

Route 175A North, Big Apple - Citgo, Gas & Diesel, 4 AM through 11 PM

Exit 32 - Lincoln, NH - This is your last option before you start the long climb up through Franconia Notch.

Route 112 East, BP - 7 Eleven, Gas & Diesel, 24 hours
